Christmas school holiday activities 2023/2024

Full payment is due seven days before camp begins. Cancellations within 7 days of camp only allowed if another suitable rider can be found to take your place. If not, camp fees are payable in full. If your child leaves camp for sickness or any other reason at all camp fees are non- refundable.

Camps run 9am-5pm each day (unless stated otherwise). Lunch/ snacks are provided. Please bring your own drink

bottle for water. Special dietary requirements can be catered for if notified in advance!

Pre Christmas camps

December 12/13/14th. \$330 per child

Horse riding, arts and crafts, swimming in the dam, and Christmas shopping!

This camp will include a shopping trip to Canberra Centre on the 13th- If you'd like to send your kids with money to buy you a present for Christmas then this is a good time for them to shop! Pick up on the day can be from Canberra centre at 4.30pm or Redlands at 5pm.

This camp will also cover the events taking place at the show on the weekend. Suited for riders competent beginner and up.

We may or may not have our horse wrapping challenge!

Redlands Show December 16th/17th (program now available)

December 20/21st \$220 per child All levels capable beginner and up

Two day camp (9am-5pm each day) riding, games, Christmas activities, swimming. Suitable competent beginners and up.

What is a capable beginner/ intermediate rider? This camp is not intended for absolute beginners who have never ridden before. If you have not ridden at Redlands before you will be required to attend an assessment lesson before camp.

Beginner riders should at a minimum be able to safely steer, walk and trot in a group situation in an enclosed arena. They should not be required to be on a lead.

What is an intermediate/ advanced rider?

These camps will involve jumping activities from 45cm +. Riders should be capable of saddling their own horse with minimal help (we will of course check the gear before riding) and confident riding in an open field. It is not required to jump bigger than a small course of jumps at trot, but riders should be capable of cantering in a group situation safely in an open area.

- You need to be aged 7 or older unless you have a parent/ guardian able to help you throughout the camp. (Exceptions may apply- please just ask us)
- Beginners/ Little kids campers do not need to have ridden before. These camps are designed for beginners and younger children.
- We normally do dressage/ hacking activities in the morning, and after lunch we do games and jumping. Please don't worry if you can't or don't want to jump yet. We have activities to suit all levels and we are well used to making sure everyone gets a go at their own level. Depending on the riders present, we may even split the group into two so everyone gets a better go.
- Yes, your child will be picking up poo, cleaning yards and stables, scrubbing out water troughs, and general cleaning up. We work as a team, and all the horses on the property need to be fed and looked after during camp. Everyone is expected to help.
- Kids get plenty of time and instruction in safety around horses, saddling and unsaddling as well as handling horses on the ground, grooming, and other theory lessons.
- You are welcome to bring your own pony or horse, or you can use one of ours.

- Please understand for those riders who don't have their own horses, it is most likely you will ride different horses



throughout camp- usually everybody wants to ride the same horse- I do my best to make sure everyone gets a turn on the horse they want- but flexibility is required. If children are not comfortable riding particular horses, we do our best to make suitable matches but sharing horses may be required.

- Camps ALWAYS book out in advance. To reserve your place just book through the app. In the unlikely event that camps do not have enough bookings to run, you will be notified in advance and any monies paid fully refunded.
- In the unlikely event of some unforeseen circumstances that do not allow camps to run (weather/ instructor sickness etc)- all monies paid will be refunded.



What to bring to camp (all marked clearly with your name!)

- Riding clothes- jodhpurs, t shirts (not singlet tops) riding boots, helmet, gloves and chaps if you use them
- Casual clothes- shorts and t shirts (winter camps- tracksuits, jumpers, very warm clothes)

- Sunscreen, sunhat and sunglasses if you wear them

If you bring your own pony you will also need to bring
